

Meridian Design Build breaks ground on Morey Corp. Innovation Center

WOODRIDGE, Illinois | Construction is underway on a 26,300 square foot 2-story expansion to Morey Corp.'s Global Headquarters in Internationale Centre. This is an addition to the 95,100 square foot facility built in 1999.

Scheduled for completion in the first quarter of 2007, the building's main purpose will be to serve as a state-of-the-art technical development, engineering and testing facility for all products developed by The Morey Corp.

The facility features large volume spaces with a partial basement leading to an underground parking facility, laboratory and testing facilities, prototype display areas and a center for engineering design.

Vice President Peter Stadler is heading up the project for Meridian Design Build.

The design team for this project includes project architect, Oak Park, Illinois-based Schmidt Design, and civil engineer, Vernon Hills, Illinois-based Manhard Consulting Ltd.
