CONSTRUCTION UNDER WAY ON POLMAX FACILITY

ALSIP, ILL. — Meridian Design Build has broken ground on a 171,670-square-foot build-to-suit facility for Polmax Transportation in Alsip. The 38-acre development site includes the demolition of an existing 37,000-square-foot building. When complete, the new warehouse building will include 68 dock



positions and 20,000 square feet of office space that will serve as Polmax's corporate headquarters. A vehicle repair facility will also be constructed within the building.
