

SPEC BUILDING BREAKS GROUND IN ROMEOVILLE

Land and Lakes Development Co. broke ground in early August on Bluff Point III in Romeoville. It is in the Bluff Point Business Park on the southeast corner of Joliet and Bluff roads.

Bluff Point III, or 821 Bluff Road, is the third industrial building of this 28acre business park. The 506,777-sq.h building, divisible to 250,000 sq.f. will be located adjacent to Bluff Road at Joliet Road, in fose proximity of 1-55 and near the intersection of 1-55 and 1-55. Bluff Point III joins two existing 500,000-sq-ft buildings, 825 Bluff Road and 815 Bluff Road, developed by Land and Lakes on speculation. Both strucwere leased to their occupants, the Wrigley Co. and Prairie Packaging (now owned by Pactiv Corp.), by completion of construction in 2005 and 2007 respectively.
