GROUND BROKEN ON O'HARE LOGISTICS CENTER



Atlanta-based Seefried Properties has begun developing O'Hare Logistics Center, a 12-acre park near O'Hare International Airport at the southwest corner of Devon and Ellis avenues in Bensenville. It will include two speculative multi-tenant industrial facilities totaling 188,160 square feet. Building I (107,800 square feet), and Building II (80,360 square feet) are scheduled for completion in the 1st quarter of 2007.
