



Meridian Design Build has broken ground on O'Hare Logistics Center Bensenville, Ill.

GROUND BREAKS ON 188,160-SQUARE-FOOT O'HARE LOGISTICS CENTER

Bensenville, Ill. — Meridian Design Build, as general contractor, has broken ground on O'Hare Logistics Center, a 12-acre park being developed by Atlanta-based Seefried Properties in Bensenville. The park, which is located on the southwest corner of Devon and Ellis avenues near the Chicago O'Hare International Airport, will

feature two speculative multi-tenant industrial facilities totaling 188,160 square feet. Both the 107,800-square-foot Building I and the 80,360-square-foot Building II are designed to accommodate freight forwarding and cargo warehousing users. Completion is scheduled for first-quarter 2007. Cornerstone Architects provided architectural services for the project, while Jacob & Hefner Associates provided the civil engineering services. John Sharpe and Chris Nelson of Lee & Associates are marketing the property for the developer.
