

MERIDIAN BREAKS

GROUND ON EXPANSION

Sauk Village, Ill. — Deerfield, Ill.-based Meridian Design Build recently broke ground on a 364,000-square-foot expansion to LogistiCenter at Sauk Village, a speculative distribution center in Sauk Village. The cross-docked, rail-served expansion will increase the size of the existing facility from 412,615 square feet to 776,615 square feet once it is completed in the summer. The expansion will also include 32-foot clear-height ceilings and can accommodate up to 106 trailer stalls and 66 truck doors. Palatine, Ill.-based Harris Architects is the project architect. LogistiCenter at Sauk Village, a development by Reno, Nev.-based DP Partners and the Village of Sauk Village, was completed earlier this year.
